



## PROMOTE YOURSELF ONLINE: AS A REGISTERED OR CERTIFIED FOOD SAFETY TRAINER

NEHA's food safety training program maintains a network of hundreds of registered food safety trainers spread throughout the globe. Our trainers are integral toward the goal of bringing increased food safety to the public.

To be listed as a registered or certified food safety trainer on the NEHA website, you must first apply to become a food safety trainer. If you have not already applied to become a trainer, please do so at: [www.nehatraining.org](http://www.nehatraining.org).

Approved applicants will be issued registered or certified trainer status. All trainers must pass a CFP-ANSI food manager examination. All trainers possessing a food manager certificate will have registered status. To become a certified food safety trainer with NEHA, the trainer must possess a Certified Professional of Food Safety (CP-FS) credential or an Registered Environmental Health Specialist (REHS) or Registered Sanitarian (RS) credential.
